

COOKIES

WHAT ARE “COOKIES” A cookie is a simple text file that is stored on a user’s computer or mobile device by a website and which can be read or retrieved by the same website or server. Cookies contain information which enables the website to remember, for example, the user’s preferences or, if we are talking about e-commerce, the products placed in the shopping cart. The Directive on Electronic Communications and the Provisions from the Privacy Authority of 8 May 2014, no. 229, regarding “Identification of the simplified methods for informing subjects about, and acquiring their consent to, the use of cookies”, provide for the use of cookies that may be permitted only with the user’s consent.

BROWSER COOKIES Our site may use cookies to improve the user experience. The user’s web browser saves these cookies on the user’s computer or device in order to keep track of the visit. Users may modify their web browser settings to disable cookies, or to receive a warning when a cookie is sent. If any of these options are set, some parts of the Site may not function properly.

THE COOKIES USED BY THIS WEBSITE AND HOW TO WITHHOLD CONSENT TO THIRD-PARTY COOKIES On this site: • IT techniques are not used in any way to directly acquire a user’s personal identifying data • cookies are not used to transmit information of a personal nature • user tracking systems are not used (i.e. so-called persistent cookies) • the use of so-called session cookies is strictly limited to sending session identifying data needed to allow secure and efficient browsing of the site and, once the connection has been broken, these session cookies are not stored.

FOR THE SITES THAT USE GOOGLE ANALYTICS

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service provided by Google Inc. which, by using proprietary cookies, allows a website to analyse how users use it. The information generated by the cookies on the use of the website (including your anonymous IP address) will be transmitted to and stored on Google servers in the United States. Google will use this information to analyse how you use the website, to compile reports on site activities for the website managers and operators, and to provide other services related to the website activities and use of the internet. Google may also transfer this information to a third party where this is required by law or where such a third party processes the aforementioned information on behalf of Google. Google will not associate your IP address to any other data that Google may hold. You may disable the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate setting in your browser, even if this might hinder the use of some or even all of this website’s functionality. To disable analytical cookies and to prevent Google Analytics from collecting browsing data, you may download the browser add-on to disable Google Analytics: <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout> • It may be possible, on some pages of the site, for third parties to set their own cookies in order to trace the operation of their application or to personalise the application for you. For example, when you share an article using a social media button found on the site, the social media network that created the button will record your action.

BROWSER SETTINGS: HOT TO CHECK COOKIES The “Help” section in the user’s browser should be able to assist in managing cookie settings. If you do not wish to receive cookies, you may modify your browser settings so that you are notified whenever a website wishes to set a cookie. It is also possible to delete cookies which are stored on your device at any time, through the browser’s settings.

What types of cookies do we use?

1. **Technical cookies** are necessary for browsing our website and accessing the different products and services. Technical cookies allow us to recognise (but not identify) you and signal which pages you have looked at. They are designed to enhance your browsing experience by adapting the presentation of our website to your device's display preferences (such as language used, screen resolution etc.) and memorising passwords and other information contained in forms that you have filled out on the site. Technical cookies can also be used to implement security measures. You should not deactivate these cookies or configure them differently. If you do so, you will no longer have access to the website and/or its services.

2. **Audience measuring cookies** (also known as "analytics" cookies) are issued by us or our third party service providers. They are designed to measure the number of people accessing the different content and sections of our website in order to assess and improve them. These cookies also allow us to identify potential problems navigating the site and thus make it more user friendly. They only produce anonymous statistics and site visitor numbers; they do not collect any identifying information about individual visitors. The duration of audience measuring cookies is no longer than 13 months.

3. **"Social media" cookies** allow us to share content from our website with other people, notify them that you have visited the site or tell them what you think of its content. This applies to the "share" and "like" buttons on social networks such as Facebook and Twitter. The social networks that provide this type of button can use it to identify you, even if you did not use it while visiting our website. We suggest that you look at the privacy protection policies of these social networks for more information about how these cookies and the browsing information that they acquire through these buttons are used, particularly for advertising. The duration of these cookies is no longer than 13 months.

Facebook

The following Facebook features can be integrated into our websites and may be used to read or place Facebook cookies:

- The Facebook "like" button, which allows the user to indicate that they like something on Facebook
- Log in to Facebook, which allows the user to log in to their Facebook account and use it to interact with our websites
- Share on Facebook, which allows the user to share something with other people on Facebook
- The Facebook Social Graph, which allows our websites to extract content from Facebook such as images from the user's profile or public published posts

Your options regarding cookies

You can configure the cookies that we use on the VINCI Energies Group websites in two ways: with the **cookie management tool** that we have made available on the site, or by changing your internet browser settings. You can choose to deactivate some or all cookies at any time with the cookie settings (activation or deactivation buttons) accessible via the “more information about cookies” link in the cookie banner — with the exception of the technical cookies needed for the site to function, as explained above. You can also change your browser settings so that cookies can be saved or deleted by your device.

1. Blocking cookies with your internet browser

You can deactivate some or all cookies at any time. You can also change your browser settings to notify you when cookies are placed on your device and to ask you whether you accept them or not, either on a case by case basis or all at once). We would like to remind you, however, that deactivating all cookies will stop you from being able to use our site in the usual way, apart from the basic functions.

Each browser is configured differently when it comes to managing cookies and your choices. This will be explained in the help menu of your browser, which will tell you how to adjust your cookie settings. For:

3. Blocking social network cookies:

4. **What blocking cookies means:**

Please note that one or more specific cookies are used to take your different choices into account.
